2024 Membership Dues Schedule

Regular Social Membership - \$75 (includes 5 Sportsman's night tickets)

Senior Membership - \$50 per year (includes 5 Sportsman's night tickets)

*Senior member is 10 years good standing and over 65.

Family Membership - \$170 (includes 10 Sportsman's night tickets)

*Family membership is parents/children up to 26 years old, in the same household/address.

Archery 24/7 - \$275 (includes archery and club membership, and 5 Sportsman's night tickets)

Junior Membership (ages 12 to 15) \$5

*Junior member must be dependent of and accompanied by an Active member when at the club or ranges.

The **new member** and **late renewal** assessment will remain \$10

REQUIRED-Everyone 18 and older must provide a photo ID with address.

A Message from the Board and Officers

A reminder to club members. . .

NO guests are permitted on grounds/ranges except at public events.

Club Rules and Range Safety

A valid membership card must be displayed on your person, not on your bag, whenever you are on the ranges.

Range Hours:

Monday – Saturday: 8 am til dusk but not later than 8 pm

Sunday: 9 am till dusk but not later than 8 pm

NO guests are permitted on the ranges under any circumstances.

Ranges will be closed during certain events. Pistol League and Block Shoots. Dates and times for other planned closures are posted on website, Facebook and emailed to members.

Always observe basic firearm safety rules.

Make sure both ranges (Pistol and Rifle) are clear before walking down-range to the targets

No Bouncing or Rolling Ground Targets

No Junk Targets (e.g., bottles, cans, etc.)

No fully automatic firearms on the range

No shotguns on the pistol range

Please take down used targets and pick up your brass.

Please lock the gate on your way **in and out** of the range.

Finally, please do not shoot at the target frames, trees, or anything other than appropriate targets.

If you have a fundraising idea or would like to run an event at the club, please come to a meeting and share the details.

If you would like to be on a committee, please come to a membership meeting.
